The Government's printed text books do not help the Visually Impaired. **Nethrodaya** has always strived to assist the rural economically backward differently abled with illiterate parents by offering Free Audio Books. The books have helped them reach academic success, which has been instrumental in boosting their confidence.

Part-time Computer Diploma Courses

Nethrodaya offers part-time computer courses that can be accommodated with the mainstream study course to equip the differently abled with the basic nuances of **Microsoft Office** and to give them an equal footing in a competitive world.

Free Legal Aid

Nethrodaya supports the differently abled in distress by providing them with legal aid services in Tamil Nadu to relieve them of their legal entanglements.

An Interface with Achievers

Nethrodaya inspires its inmates by inviting differently abled achievers who have made a mark in various fields and provides a platform for the residents to interact with them.

Rehabilitating those Involved in Begging

To bring back the dignity and respect into the lives of the differently abled who have resorted to begging, **Nethrodaya** provides a seed capital of Rs.500 worth marketable products to start a small business independently.

Out reach Services

Free Medical Helpline

Physical pain for the differently abled is an addition to their existing suffering. As a pioneer effort and essentially to relieve them of such sufferings, timely quality medical intervention and care is provided in case of accidents.

Nethradenu (Individual Cattle Rearing Unit)

Nethrodaya provides cows to visually impaired adults in rural areas to augment the total family income and restore the prestige of these individuals.

Shelter for the Shelterless

Although capable of paying the monthly rent, a majority of the differently challenged find it difficult to afford the initial advance sum. **Nethrodaya** bridges this gap by finding a home, paying the advance money and finally handing over the key to the individual.

Voices of the Beneficiaries

Medical Helpline Story - Krishna

Twenty-four year old Krishna, who is from a poor family in a remote village, suffered incapacitating pain caused by acute piles. frantic search for Medical Support from the outside world proved futile and left him with no choice but to seek the help of **Nethrodaya**.

Nethrodaya admitted **Krishna** in a private hospital for the Surgery. The Timely Medical Assistance has relieved him of the agony. After getting a job, **Krishna** wishes to help someone in dire need of Medical Help.

Cow Project

Nagalakshmi, an uneducated young girl from a rural area, who was financially dependent on her family that often turned down her wishes, came to know of **Nethrodaya** and sought help. She was offered a **Hybrid Cow** and a **Female Calf**. She has become an income-generating person and does not depend on her family members. With her new economic status and improved dignity and self esteem, she is able to dream for a better future. She has promised to support similar people and to help uplift the visually challenged in her village.



Self-employment Muthu

Muthu, a peddler who sells day-to-day items in Suburban Trains had scarce resources to obtain the goods, which resulted in a lack of income for his family that was in dire need of financial support. When he approached **Nethrodaya** for financial assistance, **Nethrodaya** provided selling material to Muthu and helped him to carry out his business and to look after his family.

Achievers of Nethrodaya

The rural visually challenged lack basic facilities and are unable to continue their education, but after visiting **Nethrodaya**, their approach towards life changes. **Nethrodaya** has helped them in enhancing their capabilities and have also helped in availing government jobs by which they become economically independent and motivating role models for their families and community.

Devan Story

"I come from a poverty-stricken family and lost my sight at 22, which was traumatic and agonizing. **Nethrodaya** was instrumental in pursuing my education and my family is proud of my success."

From Achrapakkam village, Devan lost his sight at the age of 22 due to a genetic disorder and could not pursue his education due to his sudden vision loss. He approached **Nethrodaya** after almost 12 years and through the guidance and encouragement from **Nethrodaya**, he has scored 374 marks in his 10th standard exams in his first attempt proving that age is not a barrier for performance.





RRD Story

The ambition of orthopaedically impaired graduates is to work in an MNC. **Nethrodaya** has fulfilled this dream by providing the much-required assistance, training and skills development. Today, we are happy to share that we are working in an MNC and are able to earn a sizable income and are able to support our family members and others.

Mahalakshmi Story

I come from Sillakudi village, Perambalur. I lost my sight as a child. I have one brother and four sisters. My brother and one of my sisters also have a vision problem. I'm proud to be at **Nethrodaya** because the resources we avail at **Nethrodaya** presently are not available anywhere else. My success in the education field will set a precedent for the girls who are visually challenged and are looking for an opportunity to improve their lives.
